

EASY MODE XP – Quick Start Guide v0.8

If you start Easy Mode XP the first time, you won't see any icons within the window.

This is absolutely correct, because this is the outgoing configuration.

To set up your first icon, you have to follow this small easy guide. Let's go!

Click on "**Easy Mode XP**", left in the taskbar. A new menu will appear.

Choose "**Easy Mode XP Icon Editor**".

In the opened window, you have to select a type of application which Easy Mode XP has to start when pressing your (upcoming) new button.

In this example, we are going to set up a button which will bring us directly to the Google homepage from the Tab "Internet" on button nr 1.

Choose "**Internet – Button 1**" in the left sided list box.

Now click on the button with the small globe. You will see "<http://www.>" in the underneath textbox.

Complete these address to: <http://www.google.com>

Enter a small caption. Try "Google.com" and write it in the textbox under "Button caption".

Click the "... " button right from the textbox "Button icon" and select an icon you like (ex. "google.png").

At last, you see the checked option "**Offline**". That means that your new button will be (and is still) hidden. So uncheck this to show your icon within the Easy Mode XP window.

Now click on "**Save**", then on "**Restart Easy Mode XP**".

After a few seconds of loading time, your first button on the Easy Mode XP interface will appear.

That's all!
